MEDICINE AND SUPPLY (general list)

1. Adult Multivitamins
2. Children’s Vitamins
3. Parasite Medicines – Adults and Children

4. Adult Cough and Cold
5. Children's and Infant Cough and Cold
6. Dermatology – antifungal crème, hydrocortisone, moisturizer, lice shampoo, bacitracin, etc
7. Infant – wipes and diapers
8. Women's – vaginal cream, condoms, prenatal vitamins
9. Pain – adult, children, and infant (Tylenol, Advil, etc)
10. Antibiotics – adult and children –
amoxicillin, cephalexin, septrin, cipro, erythromycin, bactrin, augmentin,
etc.
11. Allergy – antihistamine, singulair, alegra, benadryl, etc.
12. Asthma- albuterol inhalers, nebulizer machine
13. Diabetes- metformin, glyburide
14. ENT – eye, ear drops, throat spray,
15. Heart -enalapril
16. GI – cimetidine, ranitidine, famotidine, immodium, antacids, pepcid, prevacid
17. Mental Health – anxiety, (ativan, xanax)
18. Dental – toothbrushes, toothpaste, floss, Listerine
19. Eyeglasses (reading only)
20. Clothes, shoes, toys, books
21. Supplies – Office – plastic bags of all sizes, small envelopes, baggies, paper, pens,
labels, large clear plastic bins for meds
22. Supplies – Medical – gloves, hand sanitizer, stethoscopes, blood pressure cuffs,
thermometers and thermometer covers, tongue depressors, gauze, tape, band aids,
glucose monitor, scales, etc.
